The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.245 dated 09.05.2017 registered at Police Station Gannaur, District Sonapat under Sections 354-D, 365, 376-D, 511, 506 and 34 of IPC and Section 8 of POCSO Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the statement made by the prosecutrix. He states that the prosecution had turned hostile and has not supported the prosecution version.

Allegations had been levelled by the victim regarding attempt of rape. At the trial, she has not supported the prosecution version.

Sonu one of the co-accused had been allowed bail vide *CRM-M-7568-2018*.

The petitioner is in custody since 14.05.2017.

The trial would take time. The petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate on the condition that the petitioner would not approach the victim or her family members.
