Petitioner seeks regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.39 dated 02.05.2016, under Sections 18/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 10 kgs. of opium was effected from the present petitioner as also two other co-accused, namely, Simranjit Singh and Pardeep Kumar.

During the course of hearing today, it has gone uncontroverted that co-accused Simranjit Singh has been granted benefit of bail in the light of order dated 04.04.2018 in CRM No.M-12879 of 2018.

In the considered view of this Court the reasoning adopted by this Court in the case of co-accused Simranjit Singh would even apply qua the present petitioner.

Accordingly, present petition is allowed in terms of

order dated 04.04.2018 passed by this Court in CRM No.M-12879 of 2018 (Simranjit Singh Vs. State of Punjab).

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
