CRM-M-11982 of 2015

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of order dated 03.03.2015 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak, whereby revision petitions filed by respondents no.2 and 3 challenging order dated 14.02.2015, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Rohtak, have been allowed. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Rohtak, had allowed the application under Section 190 (1) (b) Cr.P.C., filed by the petitioner and had summoned respondents no.2 and 3. Order dated 14.02.2015, was set aside by the revisional Court. Hence aggrieved, this petition was filed.

The following order was passed on the last date of hearing:-

“None had appeared on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today as well despite the counsel for the petitioner being notified of the date fixed.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 24.05.2018.

The concerned SHO is directed to ensure the presence of the petitioner before this Court on the next date of hearing.”

Learned counsel for the State, informs on instructions from SHO Rajinder Singh that SI Raj Kumar duly informed the petitioner of the date fixed before this Court but she refused to accompany him to Court and stated that she will be represented by her counsel.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that she is no longer interested in pursuing this matter.
