Affidavit of the General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Rohtak, in terms of the order dated 6.11.2017 has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that since the pay of the petitioners has been notionally fixed in the scale of Rs.4000-6000, from the date of their appointment, and they have been released the arrears w.e.f. 1.4.2013, nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of as infructuous.

However, learned Senior counsel for the petitioners points out that even though in paragraph 5 of the affidavit it is stated that the arrears of salary have since been deposited by the department in the Treasury on

17.10.2017, 12.10.2017 and 29.09.2017, but the petitioners have not been disbursed the requisite amount.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the necessary amount shall be released to the petitioners within three weeks from today.

That being so, learned Senior counsel for the petitioners submits that the petition be disposed of in the above terms.

Ordered accordingly.
