It is contended that petitioner No.1 – Suman, aged about 19 years has got married with petitioner No.2- Talwinder Singh, aged about 20 years, against the wishes of her parents, who are arrayed as private respondents No.4 to 6 and they have been trying to interfere in their marital life, as such to seek protection in that regard, they have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

Heard.

Though this marriage is in violation of Section 5 of the Hindu

Marriage Act but even then no physical harm to petitioners can be

allowed to be caused by private respondents No.4 to 6.

As such, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), District Jalandhar to look into the grievances of the petitioners and to take necessary measures to ensure that no harm is caused to petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 or persons claiming under them.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
