Petitioner seeks concession of bail during the investigation in case FIR No.196 dated 23.12.2017, under Sections 406/420/IPC, registered at Police Station Lambran, District Jalandhar.

FIR came to be registered on the complaint of Salim son of Dalbir Chand.

Allegations precisely against the present petitioner and other co-accused are that a sum of Rs.06 lacs has been misappropriated which the complainant party had entrusted to the present petitioner as also her husband on the pretext of being sent abroad i.e. to Germany.

Counsel during the course of hearing today concedes that a sum of Rs. 2,30,000/- had been received and even an agreement had been scribed between the parties.

The matter is still under investigation.

Allegations of people being duped of their hard earned money on the pretext of being sold a foreign dream are on the rise these days.

State counsel informs the Court that the petitioner is involved in yet another FIR involving similar allegations.

In an overview of the matter, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner the concession of bail at this stage.

Petition dismissed.
