Petitioner alleges inaction on the part of the police despite registration of criminal case against respondents No.4 to 7 and two unknown persons.

The grievance of the petitioner is that despite his request, the police has not acted lawfully. Even the CCTV footage has not been taken into consideration for the purposes of proper investigation. FIR No.287 dated 07.12.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC (326 IPC added lateron) has already been registered in Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

The petitioner has already filed a representation before the Police Commissioner, Amritsar vide diary No.846

dated 27.12.2017.
