Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.46 dated 4.4.2017 under sections 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Payal, District Ludhiana.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 140 grams of white powder was effected from the petitioner and which as per report of the Chemical Examiner has been found to be containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride.
