The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking permission to go to abroad in Canada for six months to the petitioner with adequate bail bonds before the learned trial Court in case FIR No.206 dated 01.09.2001 offence punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Haibowal, Ludhiana pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that daughter of the petitioner is residing in Canada and petitioner wants to go to meet her, there is no other family member by visiting her. Therefore, he may be allowed to go to abroad.

On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the prayer by contending that case is pending against the petitioner.
