The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking a direction to the official respondents to complete further investigation in case FIR No. 205 dated 12.8.2014 registered at Police Station Patti, District Police Commisionerate Tarn Taran under Sections 354-A and 354-D IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the petitioner has already submitted a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran, but no action has been taken thereon and prays that the respondents be directed to decide the said representation expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. A.S. Sandhu, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner dated 1.1.2017

(Annexure P/4) within a period of one month, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 1.1.2017 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
