According to the reply filed by the State, the petitioners were never harrassed or in future they would not be harassed. Only once raid has been conducted on their house in search of son of petitioners No.1 and 2 namely Gurwinder Singh, who has been declared as proclaimed offender. The petiitoners were never called in the police station.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as having become infructuous, with a direction to the respondents not to harass the petitioners or call them in police station, without issuance of one week's prior notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.
