This is a petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life, limb and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 10.

Undisputedly, petitioner-Harpreet Kaur is married and has a living spouse. She wanted to live with her own free sweet will with co-petitioner-Bikramjit Singh. She is seeking protection of her life from her husband-Gurwinder Singh, father-in-law-Balwant Singh, mother-in-law-Gyan Kaur and sisters-in-law-Simarjeet Kaur and Sharnjit Kaur as well as her parents Jasvir Singh (father) and Jaswnat Kaur (mother).

To the mind of this Court, she is having a living spouse and has no right to live with co-petitioner/Bikramjit Singh. In these circumstances, she is not entitled to any relief as prayed for in this petition.

Dismissed.
