This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.144 dated 20.12.2015 under sections 406, 420, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Balongi, District S.A.S Nagar, Mohali.

At the very outset, it may be noticed that petitioner no.2 was arrested and accordingly the instant petition had been withdrawn by counsel qua petitioner no.2 and which would be reflected in the order dated 24.10.2017 passed by this Court.

In so far as petitioner no.1 is concerned the allegations are that she had received a sum of Rs.4 lacs from the complainant to facilitate his employment as a Driver.

Counsel would argue that petitioner no.1 namely Ramesh Kumari herself is serving as a Class-IV employee and as such, there would be no occasion for the complainant to have paid such a huge amount so as to arrange employment on the post of Driver.
