AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is residing in Canada and was not even aware of the proceedings initiated against the petitioner in FIR No.52 dated 03.04.2006. It has now come to light that the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender in the proceedings before the trial Court and it has further so happened that against co-accused Balwinder Kaur wife of Joginder Singh, the learned trial Court has acquitted her vide judgment dated 25.08.2012 (Annexure P-1). He, therefore, states that the petitioner would surrender before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar, on or before 18.04.2018 and move an application for grant of regular bail.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar, on or before 18.04.2018 and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be considered and decided at an early date, preferably within a period of one week.

Till a decision is taken on that application, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
