Petitioners have approached this Court praying for protection of their life and liberty as is apparent in the argument, which has been raised by the counsel for the petitioners.

A complaint has been filed by respondent No. 6-Usha Devi daughter of Ratti Ram, who is stated to be wife of petitioner No. 1-Jagroop Singh, in which the petitioners have been summoned time and again by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Fazilka.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners had already joined the enquiry proceedings and have submitted all the necessary documents but they are being again called by the Deputy Superintendent of Police.

There can be no order passed by this Court, whereby a direction can be issued in the present facts and circumstances that the enquiry cannot be held by the Deputy Superintendent of Police in the light of the fact that there is a complaint preferred by respondent No. 6-Usha Devi. However,

the notice under Section 160 Cr. P.C., as mandated, be served upon the petitioners in future if they are required for enquiry.

The petitioners shall join enquiry on 30.03.2018, as has been stated by the counsel for the petitioners.

With these observations, the petition stands disposed of.
