Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos. 4 and 5 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 25.03.2018 (Annexure P-6) addressed to the Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No. 2.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No. 2 and S.H.O., Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh-respondent No. 3, to look into the representation dated 25.03.2018 (Annexure P-6) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the

present petition is disposed of with directions to the Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No. 2 and S.H.O., Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh-respondent No. 3, to look into the representation dated 25.03.2018 (Annexure P-6) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
