Learned State counsel submits that the present petition was filed with the allegation that the brother of the petitioner had been wrongly accused of committing an offence under the NDPS Act, 1985 and because of the said allegation, the petitioner is also being threatened. Now, the brother of the petitioner has been acquitted and therefore, the threat if any, has also ceased to exist.

The order sheet of this case shows that none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner since 06.04.2017. It is, thus, clear that the petitioner is not interested in this case.
