The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.448, dated 27.10.2017, registered under Sections 307, 394, 511, 34, 120-B and 201 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar, District Sonapat.

2. Perused Case Diary.
3. The petitioner was arrested on 15.11.2017.
4. It transpires that the petitioner himself was not personally involved in the actual occurrence of assault as a Security Guard in the Cash van and his involvement is limited to being a planner behind the screen.

The material available against him, however, is based upon the disclosure statements of the other accused persons alone which *per se* would not be admissible.

5. In the given circumstances, considering the detention undergone by the present petitioner, namely Ram Dass son of Naresh, he may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned, with a further direction to report at the concerned Police Station once a week till such time as thought fit and proper by the Ld. Trial Court after the matter actually comes up for trial post-commitment.
