Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents for registration of appropriate case against respondents No.3 to 17.

Petitioner has alleged that he was married to respondent No.3 on 29.04.2015 as per Muslim rites and rituals in Chandigarh. That was a love marriage. In the context of matrimonial discord, petitioner has alleged some allegations leading to his journey along with his wife to Jammu where he was confined.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioner has moved a representation before respondent No.2 with a copy to respondent No.1A.
