P.B.BAJANTHRI, J. (ORAL)

In the instant petition, petitioners are seeking quashing of DDR No. 36, dated 09.03.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC in case FIR No.34 dated 09.03.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar (Annexure P-1) and consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 14.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that present FIR is an outcome of sudden quarrel and now the matter has now been resolved and sought for quashing of FIR in view of compromise.

3. This Court by the order dated 02.04.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Sub Divisional

Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib has sent his report dated 12.04.2018 wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded and compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

4. In view of the law laid down in “*Anita Maria Dias and another versus State of Maharashtra and another*” (2018) 3 SCC 290, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and DDR No. 36, dated 09.03.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC in case FIR No.34 dated 09.03.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners subject to payment of litigation cost of Rs.3000/- by each of the petitioner to State of Punjab. Cost shall be remitted in the Treasury, State of Punjab within a period of 3 months from today.
