Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.198 dated 10.12.2016 under Sections 323, 325, 452, 506, 341 IPC, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 11.04.2017, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation. It is further submitted that the anticipatory bail application of co-accused Prem Singh has already been confirmed vide order dated 20.11.2017 passed in CRM-M-26827-2017.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagjit Singh and on the basis of affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 11.04.2017 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
