Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos. 5 to 8 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 23.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar-respondent No. 2.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar-respondent No. 2 and S.H.O., Police Station Maqboolpura, District Amritsar-respondent No. 3 and S.H.O., Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran-respondent No. 4 to look into the representation dated 23.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar-respondent No. 2 and S.H.O., Police Station Maqboolpura, District Amritsar-respondent No. 3 and S.H.O., Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran-respondent No. 4 to look into the representation dated 23.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
