The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.121 dated 19.08.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 466, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 02.04.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded with regard to genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala

has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of Complainant-Amritpal Kaur @ Amrit Kaur as well as of accused, namely, Jaimal Singh, Balwinder Singh and Karaj Singh, have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant-Amritpal Kaur @ Amrit Kaur has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala, that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence, threat or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.121 dated 19.08.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 466, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
