Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for taking appropriate action against respondent No.4 in the context of allegations of harassment and threatening given by him to the petitioner.

It appears that there was a contested litigation vis-a-vis demolition of water course. FIR No.55 dated 28.07.2011 for the offence under Sections 188, 379, 427, 506 IPC, Police Station Sadar, Sri Muktsar Sahib was registered against the petitioner in which petitioner was convicted and sentenced by the trial Court, however acquitted by the court of Sessions. Apparently, the appeal against acquittal is pending in the High Court.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioner has filed a representation/complaint before respondent No.2 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner alleges that *dehors* the aforesaid litigation, respondent No.4 is instrumental in violating the legal rights of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing any reply, as no order prejudicial to the interest of either party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
