JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 148 dated 08.10.2015, under Sections 498-A and 406 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Bhogpur Jalandhar, while averring that there are no specific allegations therein regarding cruelty towards the complainant and misappropriation of dowry articles.

At this stage, learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 submits that FIR was registered in the year 2015 and proceedings under the said FIR are already underway. In fact, out of eleven witnesses summoned, evidence of three witnesses has already been recorded.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the

fact that the trial is underway and the petitioners have been appearing in Court through their counsel and also the fact that only a few witnesses are left to be examined, no interference is called for at this stage. The interim relief is granted to the petitioners that they are permitted to continue appearing before the trial Court through their counsel.

Petition stands disposed of.
