Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C, for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.104 dated 30.01.2018, registered under Sections 186, 332, 341, 353, 506, 323, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Hisar.

As per prosecution version, the driver and conductor were on the one hand and the motorcyclists were on the other hand. The allegations against the petitioner are that he caused injuries to one passenger Ramesh Kumar and also snatched Rs.4160/- from him. However, subsequently, offence under Section 379 IPC was deleted. The challan has already been submitted.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case,

I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 16.04.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
