This petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, has been moved by the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint No. 7738/2015 dated 24.12.2015, under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

The petitioner was convicted by the trial Court in pursuant to proceedings initiated by the complainant under the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, vide judgment dated 12.1.2017. The petitioner preferred a criminal appeal and the same is pending before Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh.

This Court vide order dated 22.1.2018 directed the petitioner to put in appearance before the Appellate Court on 24.1.2018 and they would be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Appellate Court.

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Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have appeared before the Appellate Court and have been released on interim bail on 24.1.2018. Learned counsel for the petitioners further states that the amount involved in the present case is Rs.50,000/- and the petitioner will deposit an amount of Rs.60,000/- through demand draft before the Appellate Court.

Let the petitioner deposit the demand draft of Rs.60,000/- before the Appellate Court subject to the out come of the appeal. The Appellate Court may disburse the said amount on terms and conditions as deemed appropriate.

In view of the above, the order dated 22.1.2018 is made absolute.

The petition is allowed.
