Petitioner has approached this Court praying for grant of anticipatory bail for the reason that he has not appeared before the trial Court on 27.11.2017.

A perusal of the order indicates that the case was called repeatedly but the petitioner did not appear and this was also on 27.11.2017 when the next date fixed as 06.12.2017. Petitioner could have thereafter on subsequent dates appeared before the trial Court and surrendered and sought regular bail or restoration of the bail bonds/surety bonds. The petitioner appeared to have absented himself on various occasions before the trial Court after the cancellation of the bail bonds and issuance of non-bailable warrants of arrest.

No ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out. The application stands dismissed.
