This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents to represent final report under Section 173 of Code of Criminal Procedure in FIR No.161 dated 30.10.2017 registered under Sections 323, 452, 436, 427, 148, 149 Indian Penal Code at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned authorities to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-5) within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. He is further directed to submit status report before concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate, who will monitor the investigation in accordance with the guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. and others**; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.
