**KULDIP SINGH J. (Oral)**

Report received from learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Abohar to the effect that statements of the complainant and the accused have been recorded and that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily.

FIR was registered on the allegations that the money was paid to the accused to get job. Case is still under investigation. Parties have amicably settled the dispute. Therefore, the trial of the case will lead to nowhere as the complainant is likely to back out from his statement.

It being so, the trial will be a useless exercise. As such, FIR No.73 dated 12.7.2016 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Bhaw Wala, District Fazilka along with

consequential proceedings stands quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
