The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.181 dated 6.7.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 15 and 16 of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substance Act, at Police Station Sadar, Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Heard.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Vijay Singh, PS Sadar, Dabwali states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Further states that only 15 killograms of poppy husk has been recovered which falls within non-commercial quantity.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this

petition is allowed and the order dated 25.4.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
