Petitioner-Jagbir Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.414 dated 01.06.2017, registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR has been got registered by the present petitioner as complainant alleging that an agreement to sell was forged and signed as witnesses by Savinder and Shamsheer.

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It is argued that during investigation, the police found that the present complainant himself has committed cheating by executing two agreements qua the same property.

Challan has already been presented and charges have already been framed. The petitioner has been in custody since 18.01.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
