At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that representation Annexure P1 was filed by son of the petitioner namely Gurmail Singh as special power of attorney of the petitioner.

Petitioner has filed this petition for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for taking appropriate action against respondents No.4 and 5 on the ground that respondent No.4 filed a civil suit for specific performance of agreement to sell dated 16.01.2006 against the petitioner in respect of immovable property. At the time of filing of the suit, petitioner was in New Zealand. Petitioner was

proceeded against *ex parte* on 25.02.2010 and *ex parte* decree was passed on 25.02.2012. Trial Court dismissed the application under Order 9 Rule 13 CPC filed by the petitioner on 18.04.2017, however in Civil Revision No.7451 of 2017, operation of the order has been stayed.

Petitioner has alleged some incriminating allegations against the private respondents for which representation dated 05.02.2018 (Annexure P1) is pending before respondent No.2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on being marked, now the representation is pending before respondent No.3.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl., A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to have a fair look on the representation (Annexure P1) dated 05.02.2018 made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without being

influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
