Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.26 dated 13.02.2018, registered under Sections 380 and 457 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Nagina, District Nuh.

The recovery of buffalo, paria and four goats and one vehicle were recovered from the house of co-accused Aas Mohd.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Banwari Lal, 229, Police Station Nagina, District Mewat, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 04.04.2018, passed by this court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
