Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 35 dated 18.02.2018, under Sections 304-B, 498-A, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Division No. 3, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Petitioner is the mother-in-law of the deceased. The petitioner's son was married to the deceased for two years prior to the occurrence in question. A daughter was born out of this wedlock. The petitioner's daughter-in-law hanged herself to death. It is contended that there are no specific allegations against the petitioner who had in fact taken her to the hospital. The petitioner's son it is stated is behind bars. It is thus prayed that this petition be allowed.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the file.

There are specific allegations against the petitioner alongwith other co-accused. The petitioner's daughter-in-law committed suicide within two years of marriage in the matrimonial home.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not find any ground whatsoever to afford the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is accordingly dismissed.
