The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 162 dated 05.10.2016, registered under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

The petitioner was apprehended at the spot and was taken into custody. The trial Court granted him interim bail during the period report of the FSL was awaited. After receipt of the report, the interim bail was cancelled vide order dated 14.03.2017. Thereafter, the petitioner should have surrendered before the trial Court. However, he has absconded till date and has filed the present petition.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has consciously absconded for more than one year, he is not entitled to concession of anticipatory bail. The petition is not maintainable and is, accordingly, dismissed.
