In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 of Cr.P.C in case FIR No.10 dated 26.01.2018 registered under Sections 406, 120-B IPC at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn-Taran.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner was granted the benefit of interim bail vide order dated 17.04.2018 and directed to join investigation. Pursuant to order dated 17.04.2018, petitioner already join the investigation and prayed for making the order dated 17.04.2018 absolute.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harwant Singh submitted that pursuant to the order dated 17.04.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of these factual aspect, without commenting on the merit of the case, order dated 17.04.2018 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition stands allowed accordingly.

6. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.
