The bail bonds of the petitioner, who was earlier stated to be on bail, were ordered to be cancelled by the learned trial Court on the ground that he had not appeared before that Court on 23.01.2018. Even as per the custody certificate filed in Court today by learned State counsel, it is seen that in a case instituted against the petitioner under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act on 20.11.2017, he was in custody from 20.12.2017 to 17.02.2018.

That being so, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail upon his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
