The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 911 dated 16.10.2017, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 506 IPC at Police Station Model Town, Panipat.

It is not in dispute that the challan in this case has already been presented and the charges have also been framed. Thus, the anticipatory bail petition is not maintainable.

At this stage, learned senior counsel appearing of the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and seek regular bail.

The prayer is reasonable and is granted. The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and seek regular bail. In case such an application is moved, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the trial Court and in any case not later than three days from the date of filing of the application.
