**SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)**

The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.138 dated 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2017, registered under Sections 302/201/34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar.

2. The petitioner who is a woman was arrested on 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2017.

3. Admittedly, there is no direct evidence available to

prove that death of the victim was for any unnatural reason since admittedly he was cremated without even holding an Autopsy.

4. The only evidence available in the Case Diary indicates certain statements attributed to the petitioner herself which are not admissible in accordance with law.

5. In addition the complainant has already been examined from the prosecution side.

6. Two of the challaned accused have already been granted bail earlier by this Court.

7. In the circumstances, further indefinite detention of the present petitioner at this stage is therefore not justified. As such she may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
