Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that because of pendency of application for adding the offence under Section 304-B IPC, the trial is not proceeding and the custody is much more which comes to about 02 years and four months.

Learned State counsel submits that out of total 14 witnesses, three witnesses have been examined and the next date before the trial Court is fixed for 10.08.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition. However, he requests that a direction may be issued to the trial Court to expedite the trial.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

However, keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the trial Court is directed to make all efforts to decide the pending application and also to expedite the trial preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
