Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.179 dated 15.11.2016, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana.

It is informed that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 22.12.2017. It is informed that petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, has been filed. The petitioner undertakes to abide by the terms and conditions of the settlement. It is thus prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for respondent no.2 submits that in view of the settlement between the parties, respondent no.2 has no objection in case this petition is allowed subject to the petitioner strictly adhering to the terms and conditions of the settlement. Respondent no.2 also agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the settlement.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Harnek

Singh, affirms and verifies that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not involved in any other criminal case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, but without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Consequently, order dated 11.05.2017 is made absolute.

It is clarified that none of the observations made hereinabove shall be construed to be a reflection on the merits of the case. The same are solely confined for the purpose of decision of the present petitions.
