Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of order dated 4.4.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and moreover, the matter has been compromised between the parties. As per terms and conditions of the compromise, the petitioner has paid an amount of ₹65,000/- to complainant-Raj Rani, who along with her son, namely, Harpreet Singh is present in Court and the same has duly been accepted by her. Both the parties have been identified by their respective counsel. Remaining amount of ₹1,05,000/- will be paid at the time of filing of petition for quashing of the FIR, as per terms and conditions of the compromise.

The factum of joining the investigation by the petitioner as well compromise arrived at between the parties, has been affirmed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh.

In view of the above, interim order dated 4.4.2018 passed in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
