In these circumstances, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.1.2018 is made absolute, subject to fulfillment of conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is made clear, that in case the petitioner is found violating any terms and conditions, the order granting pre-arrest bail shall be liable to be withdrawn.
