[3]. The order passed by the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran rejecting the petitioner's bail application on 05.12.2017 (Annexure P-2) is self-contained and substantially a balanced narration of the allegations. It is now contended on behalf of the petitioner that actually he had innocently sought lift from the co-accused on the relevant date and had otherwise no connection with the said accused.

[4]. In view of the fact that the FIR discloses about the involvement of the petitioner on the basis of prior secret information, the justification raised on behalf of the petitioner at this stage cannot be accepted. He is at liberty to urge these submissions at the appropriate stage in the Trial Court after closure of the prosecution evidence.

[5]. In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to grant benefit of bail at this stage.
