DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.(ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.0095, dated 26.02.2018, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case whereas dispute is of civil in nature. A suit was filed by complainant which is still pending. The FIR has been registered just to put pressure upon the petitioner to compromise the dispute. The sale deed was executed in the month of December 2014. Petitioner is in custody since 20.03.2018. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that investigation has been completed and trial of

the case may take long time to conclude.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Ishwar submits that there has been a compromise between the parties, petitioner has paid the loan amount to the bank as per letter written by the bank on 25.05.2018. The custody period as well as pendency of the suit have also not been disputed.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and by considering that loan amount has been deposited with the bank and there has been compromise between the parties the investigation of the case has been completed; trial may take some time to conclude; the compromise has been effected between the parties and also the fact that civil suit is pending, no purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
