Affidavit of petitioner No.1-Komaljit Kaur has been filed in Court, which is taken on record.

Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos. 4 to 7 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 01.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar-respondent No.2.

Counsel for the petitioners states that a copy of representation dated 01.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) shall be submitted by the petitioners to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural)-respondent No.2. He further states that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural)-respondent No.2 and the Station House Officer, P.S. Matewal, District Amritsar-respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 01.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners

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and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural)-respondent No.2 and the Station House Officer, P.S. Matewal, District Amritsar-respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 01.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
