The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.247 dated 26.10.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Sections 3(1) & 5(1) of the Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation Act, 1995 registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar.

2. This Court vide order dated 04.04.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned counsel for the State on instructions from Inspector Kulwant Singh submitted that petitioner has joined the investigation. Even though she is involved in other cases she has joined in two matters relating to investigation. She is facing trial in other matters wherein she has been extended bail. It has also submitted that her presence is no more required for

the time being to interrogate her.

4. In view of these facts and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 04.04.2018, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
