RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 05 dated 10.02.2012 under Sections 452/323/148/149 of the IPC registered at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 18.07.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Magistrate, Moga and got recorded their statements qua compromise on 14.08.2018. Report from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Magistrate, Moga, vide

letter No.268 dated 11.09.2018, through learned District and Sessions Judge, Moga, vide Endst. No. 4492/EB, Dated 12.09.2018, has been received. According to the report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Magistrate, Moga, the compromise is genuine and it is voluntarily effected between the parties with their free consent and without any pressure, threat, coercion or undue influence from any side.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR No. 05 dated 10.02.2012 under Sections 452/323/148/149 of the IPC registered at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioners is quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana, High Court, Rs. 1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs. 5,000/- with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Legal Services Committee, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
