The petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty from respondent No. 4.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity to issue notice to respondent No. 4 at this stage.

The allegations made by the petitioner are that a complaint under Section 3(x) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 has been filed by the petitioner against respondent No. 4 and because of this reason he is threatening his life and liberty in order to pressurize him to withdraw the said complaint. A representation dated 06.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) has been submitted before respondent No. 2 in this regard but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No. 2 to consider the representation dated 06.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) and in case it is deemed necessary to take action thereupon in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
